Inca Grass Blocks—another alternative to permeable paving

There are a number of fairly common techniques available that allow grass to be incorporated into a pavement to provide 'the best of both worlds', i.e., the appearance of grass but the load bearing capability of a well-constructed pavement or driveway.

They can be utilised in those areas where the hard permanence of a typical pavement might be undesirable, such as in conservation areas, roadside verges, emergency services access, canal paths, farm tracks or rural settings, and they are also used for erosion control

Inca Grass Blocks can be installed by your paving contractor and easy enough to install at home. It should also be noted that special grasses ought to be selected for planting the various systems, as most ordinary seed mixtures are unlikely to be sufficiently hard-wearing to withstand being trafficked.

The Inca Grass Block provides;

- strong interlocking modular design ensuring fast installation;
- high structural integrity from a high strength modular design of 600mm x 400mm x 100mm;
- cell dimensions designed for optimal gravel retention and grading and for grass growth;
- very high porosity ensuring excellent drainage characteristics;
- Keeps the natural look of grass, but has the stability of paving stones.
- Prevents mud puddles from ruining driveways, parking lots or other large areas.
- Ensures adequate drainage.
- Allows grass to grow up through the diamond cutouts while preventing soil run off.
