

GRASS BLOCK

The Grass Block is a concrete lattice which has nearly half its surface spaced with voids. It is placed on firm ground and the spaces filled with suitable soil so that grass can grow through the voids. The lattice provides sufficient support to make a hard lawn to park cars or for pathways. It may also be used as lining on embankments of slow moving canals to prevent erosion.



Units placed flush together, forming additional chambers

50mm layer of screeded bedding sand

Stable sub-base, well drained and compacted granular material to assist drainage
